

## **MUSIC IN CALARY 2007**

There will be a series of concerts in Calary in April, to launch our programme for 2007. These will feature, as in previous years, a number of talented young musicians and will again be sponsored by Wicklow County Council.

**THURSDAY 12<sup>TH</sup> APRIL:** Soprano Sarah Power, from Bray will present a programme, which will be similar to recitals that she will give in the John Field Room and in Heiligenstadt in Vienna. Sarah is currently playing Susanna in the London Guildhall's performance of the Marriage of Figaro and will be accompanied by Andrea Linsbauer, who is well regarded in Vienna.

**FRIDAY 13<sup>TH</sup> APRIL:** An evening's entertainment featuring Rún – Deborah Armstrong (piano), Elizabeth Petcu (flute) and Martin Doyle (traditional flute). The programme will include a selection of music by Debussy, Roussel and Satie, interspersed with traditional Irish music, readings and visual imagery.

Martin Doyle is sought after internationally as a flute expert, while Elizabeth Petcu has been a leading flute player with the RTE Concert Orchestra. Deborah Armstrong, who has been performing for a number of years, holds a doctorate in piano studies from McGill University in Montreal. All are living or have lived in Bray.

**SUNDAY 15<sup>TH</sup> APRIL:** We are pleased to welcome back Sophie and Ben Cashell, who will give an afternoon recital of music for piano and cello.
